

Donation Guidelines 2023

At the Co-op, we're always looking for new ways to support our community. Whether you're hosting a gala, need donations for a community event or putting together a fundraiser, we're excited to review your request. That said, we do have some donation guidelines we as an organization adhere to below:

- Donations must benefit the local community (to us, local means Snohomish and/or Island Counties or at a Washington state level).
- We do our best to respond to donations in a timely manner, but we do need enough notice to get the donation processed. With that said, requests should be made at least 4 weeks prior to the event.
- Only one donation will be made per year to any given organization. Special consideration may be made on a case by case basis based on community need.
- If you are requesting a donation on behalf of a non-profit organization, you must provide documentation of the 501c3 status.
- Though it's not required, public acknowledgement of our donation is kindly welcomed and appreciated.

Requests made by any of the following groups will not be considered:

- Political candidates or organizations
- Third-party fundraisers
- Individuals/personal sponsorships
- Any organization that discriminates on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, disability, or status in any other protected group.

We reserve the right to alter our donation guidelines or make exceptions as we see fit.
